As you read with your child, here are some ways to make the story interactive and meaningful:

 Find & Count Llamas – Turn this book into a seek-and-find adventure! As you read, encourage your child to point out the llamas on each page and count them aloud. Reinforce their counting skills by asking: "Can you count how many llamas are on this page? What number comes next?"

 Imagination & Storytelling – Ask open-ended questions:
"What would you do if you saw ten llamas in your backyard?"
"If you could add one more llama to Billy's story, what would it be doing?"

 Act It Out – Encourage movement and imagination by asking:
"Can you jump like the dancing llamas?"
"How high can you twirl like the twirling llama?"
"Can you pretend to be a llama running a race?"

 Bringing the Story to Life – Encourage your child to draw their own silly llama adventure and count how many llamas they add.

♥ A Moment of Gratitude – At the end of the story, Billy and his mom reflect on the joy of the day and the unexpected surprises of God's love. Take a moment with your child to talk about:

"What is something surprising that made you happy today?"

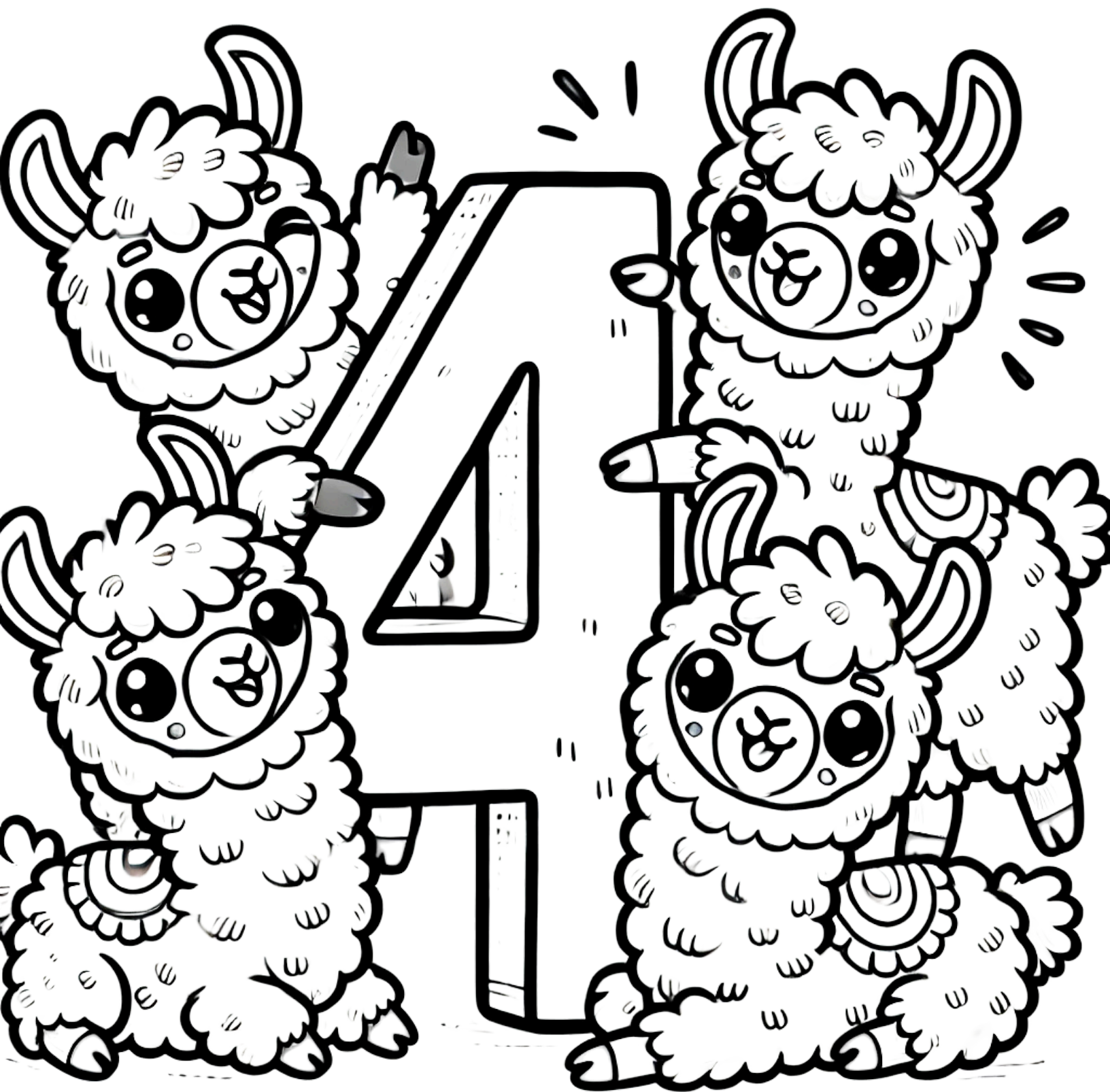
"What's one thing we can thank God for right now?"

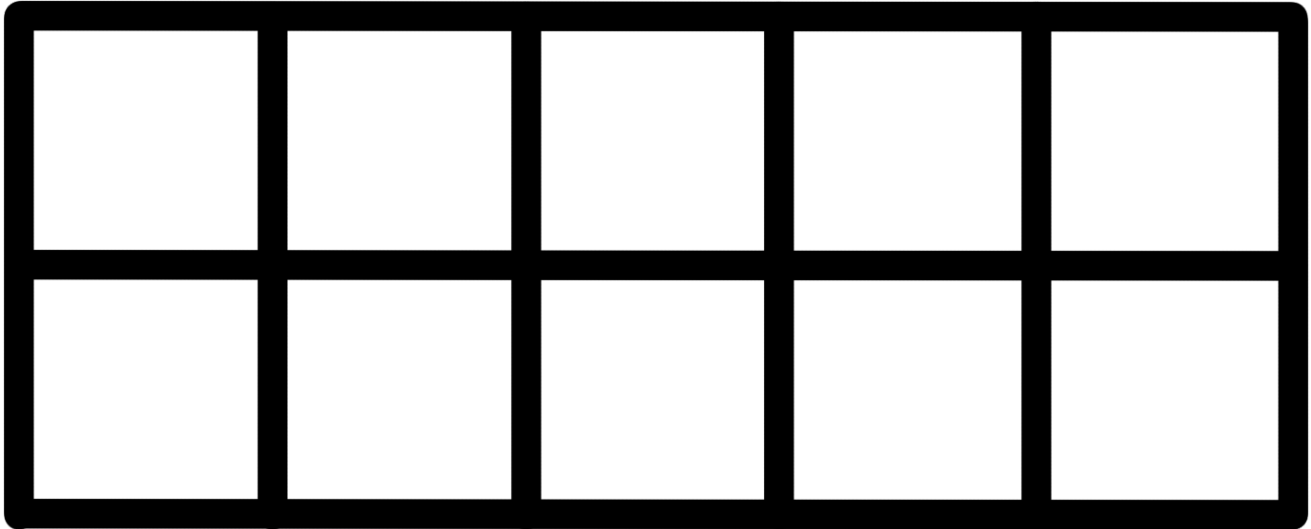
Color 2 squares in the tens bar



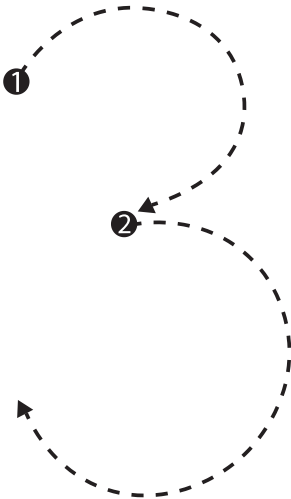
